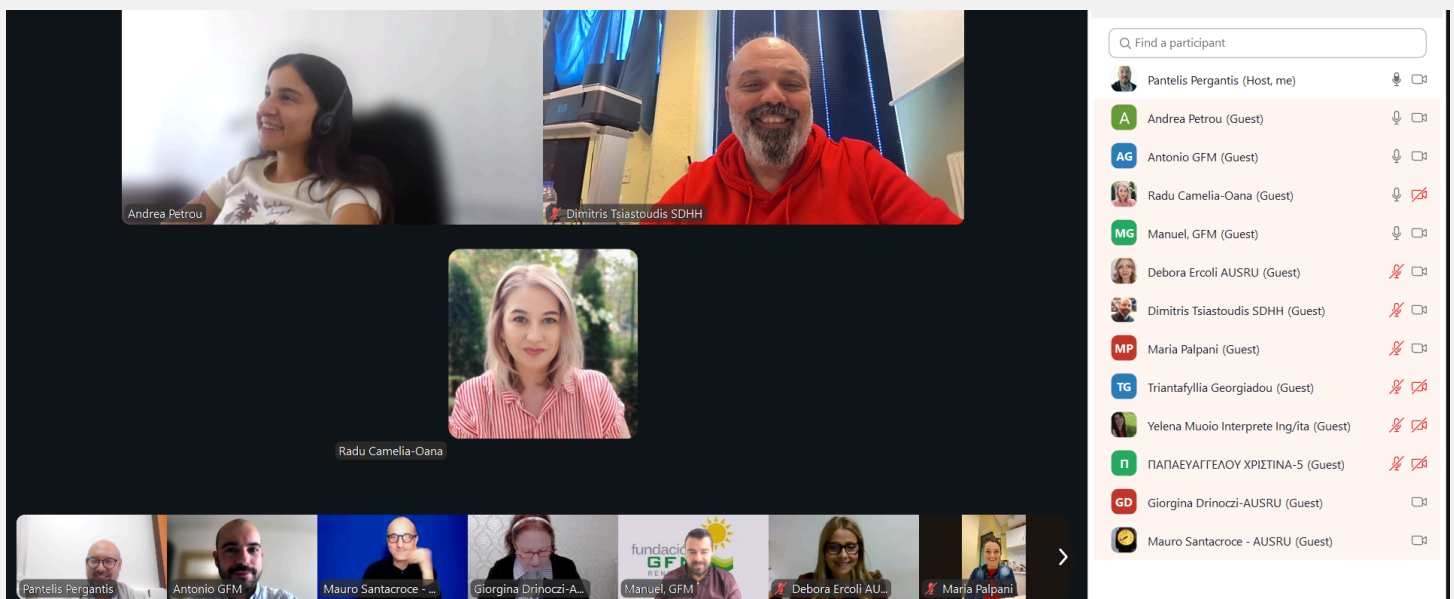


Promoting high quality, digital transformation (VR gamification) and green transition in inclusive YW practices for youth with hearing impairment (or deafness) for better employability prospects.

ENHANCING EDUCATION & EMPLOYMENT FOR DEAF

IOOnline TPM 3 – The GreenSIGNS project, co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union, has successfully held its latest transnational meeting on October 22, 2025.

The event, hosted by NSCR "Pantelis Pergantis", was held in online format, allowing remote participation of representatives from Greece, Italy, Spain, Cyprus, and Romania. This was good for instant feedback and quality discussion of steps moving forward.



A key focus of the meeting was the detailed planning of the Transnational Training Event, including content development, logistical arrangements, and partner responsibilities. The collaborative atmosphere and strong engagement of all partners contributed to constructive decision-making and a shared commitment to the project's success.

During the meeting, partners presented a comprehensive overview of the project's objectives and achievements, reaffirming GREENSIGNS' mission to promote green transition, digital innovation (including VR gamification), and inclusive youth work practices for young people who are deaf or hard of hearing. Progress across Work Packages 2, 3, 4, and 5 was reviewed in detail, confirming that activities and deliverables are being implemented on time and effectively, in line with the project plan.

1. Project outputs and implementation



Key achievements reviewed included the GreenSIGNS Interactive Map, QR Code Cards for green terms in national sign languages, the Green Jobs and Professions Index, and the ongoing Inclusive Youth Forums. Progress was also confirmed on the Competence Framework, Capacity Building Programme, and VR real-life scenarios, which underpin the upcoming training activities.

2. Next steps and preparations

A main focus of the TPM was the preparation of the Transnational Training Mobility in Cyprus, with partners coordinating roles and refining training content to ensure a high-quality learning experience for youth workers and sign language interpreters, supported by GREENSIGNS tools and VR simulations.



3. Conclusion and successes of the TPM



The meeting highlighted strong collaboration and shared commitment among partners, confirming readiness for the next project phases. Overall, the TPM represented an important milestone, strengthening cooperation and paving the way for impactful results that support green employability for young people with deafness.
